Better Stain Resistance

Seeking protection and a barrier against stains, PERMAGUARD® was developed as a protective layer on top of the material, protecting against stains from pens and some fine-point permanent markers.

Cleaning Method

We recommend cleaning at least once a week to extend the lifespan of the upholstery, preventing dirt and contamination from building up stains and becoming permanent.

- 1. Immediately wipe off any excess with a dry white cloth or fabric, but don't spread it all over the surface.
- 2. Clean the whole surface in circular motions using a clean cloth or fabric with liquid hand soap and water (1 part soap to 9 parts water). Check the guide for recommended cleaning products.
- 3. Wipe with a clean damp cloth to get rid of any excess soap.
- **4.** If there is any build-up that can't be removed with soapy water, use the following mixture: 9 parts isopropyl alcohol to 1 part water. Clean with circular motions without spreading the stain. For highly textured materials, we recommend using a soft-bristle toothbrush for a deeper cleaning. Remember, light colors need care, more often.
- 5. Clean with a clean damp cloth, wipe off and dry. Make sure there isn't any cleaning product left.

Never Use

- Solvents like paint thinner, Varsol, acetone, whiteners, waxes, silicones or detergents and/or cleaning products that are not pH neutral.
- Products that are more than 90% alcohol.
- Cleaning tools like plastic or wire sponges, or hard-bristle brushes that can damage the material permanently.
