Spot Cleaning

Basic Maintenance

We recommend cleaning at least once a week to extend the lifespan of the upholstery, preventing dirt and contamination from becoming permanent.

Clean the whole surface in circular motions using liquid hand soap and water (1 part soap to 9 parts water). Rinse and wipe with a clean damp white cloth to get rid of any excess soap. Repeat as needed and then let dry.

Once a month, you can use a soft-bristle brush for a deeper cleaning. Remember, light colors need more care, more often. If you need to disinfect the product because it has come into contact with organic material (blood, urine or fecal matter), check the guide for appropriate cleaning products and:

Clean with a white cloth or fabric. If you choose to use a bleach solution, use a concentration of 1 part bleach per 10 parts water. Rinse and wipe with a clean damp cloth or fabric to get rid of any excess. Dry.

Never Use

Solvents like paint thinner, Varsol, acetone, whiteners, waxes, silicones or detergents and/or cleaning products that are not pH neutral. Don't make marks on the product with pens or markers, it may absorb the ink stain permanently. Cleaning tools like plastic or wire sponges, or hard-bristle brushes that can damage the material permanently.
