

Care & Cleaning

Spot Cleaning

Disinfecting:

- Use only recommended disinfectants listed below.
- Apply the disinfectant.
- Do not over-apply disinfectant.
- Do not allow disinfectant to sit or pool on the material.

After Each Disinfectant Application:

- Rinse treated area with clean water then pat dry with a clean, soft cloth.
- Important: Leaving chemical residue does not increase the effectiveness of disinfectants. Chemical residues left on products will eventually cause discoloration and affect product performance.
